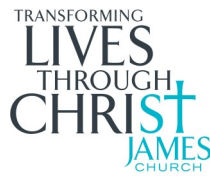

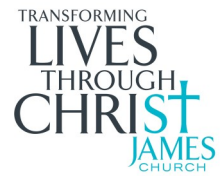

## Slum Survivor 2016 - 22 -23 October

Right now, 1 billion people live in Slums around the world. 'So that you understand how and why I live like this, walk 24 hours in my shoes....'

Those that take part will build a shelter and live in it for 24 hours. They will have limited resources, rice to eat and will have to live under the economic constraints inflicted by their slum landlords. They will seek donations for their endeavours which will be sent to a charity that actively helps the poor.

### We need your help...

....To find as much old wood, tarpaulins, rope, plastic sheeting and large pieces of cardboard which can be delivered to church on morning, or if you cannot store it then we have access to a garage across the road. Please contact Alex to arrange dropping off.

....Getting the collected wood across the road to the church yard on the morning of the 22<sup>nd</sup> Oct so that people can start building their shelters. Meet at 11 am at church, with trailers and empty cars/vans.

....To put together a security detail. Adults (must be DBS checked) who will patrol the site through the night in 2-hour stints to keep the young people safe. (Refreshments will be available.)
