Please see this extract from a letter from Bishop Emmanuel Murye Modi in Kajo Keji

'Since 25 January 2017, the situation has calmed, but over 90% of the population of Kangapa, Line and Nyepo Counties has left for refuge in Uganda. Similarly, over 70% of the people of Liwolo County and a few others from Lainya, Morobo and Yei have gathered into internally displaced camps within Liwolo, Keriwa and Ajio.

May I humbly ask you to continue to pray for lasting peace in South Sudan in general, and Kajo Keji in particular.'
